Why is Jack in the yard?

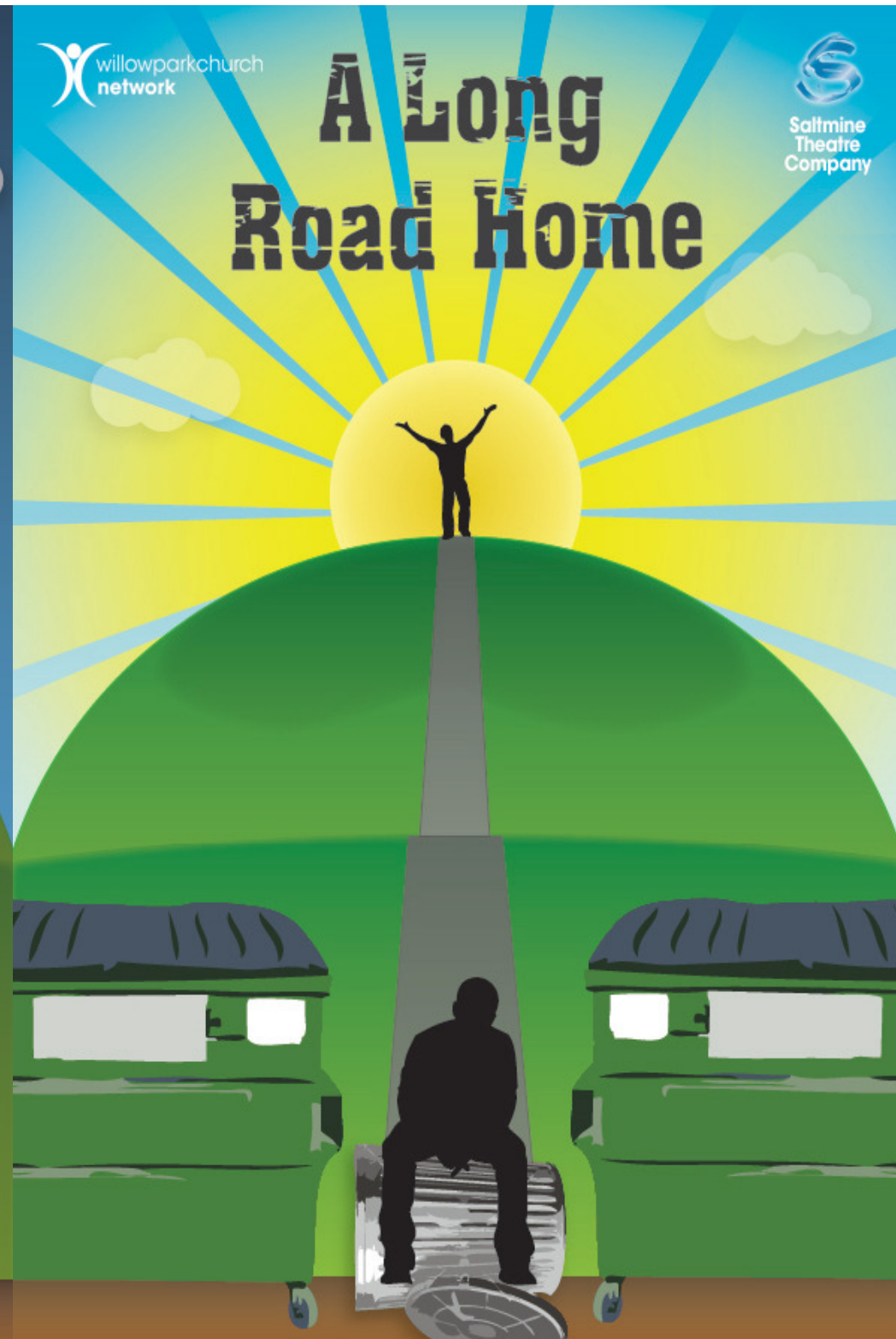
Why did he leave his home?
