Why Become A Contagious Christian?

The goal is to help each of us become contagious Christians, the kind who have caught Christ's love, and who will now make efforts to contagiously communicate this new life to all who are willing to listen.

Being Yourself

In this session, the participants will identify which of the six Evangelism Styles (Confrontational, Intellectual, Testimonial, Interpersonal, Invitational, and Serving) best describes them, and discover steps to develop that style.

Building Relationships

In this session, we will learn how to effectively reach others by first building authentic relationships with them. We will talk about where and how to build those relationships. We also will discuss how to transition into a spiritual conversation.

What's Your Story?

In this session, participants will learn why their personal story is important: their friends are interested, they can relate to it and it is hard to argue with. They will learn a method for (BC), conversion and After Christ (AD). Tips for telling their story will also be covered. Finally, the participants will write out their story and practice telling it.

What's His Story?

Session 5 presents the four points of the Gospel message (God, Us, Christ, and You). Then, two Gospel illustrations will be described and practiced: "Do vs. Done" and "The Bridge".

Crossing The Line

In session 6, the participants will practice their personal story a second time for mastery. They will also learn how to lead their non-believing friends "across the line" of faith. The four steps in crossing the line are examined: Assess Readiness, Pray, Celebrate Their Commitment, and Take The Next Step. The participants will practice praying with someone, leading them "across the line" of faith.

Putting It Together

In this session, we will not only practice the sequence of the steps of Relational Evangelism, but we will also learn some tips for telling people about Christ.

Objection

Questions and objections often come up along the way. In the final session of this course we will address some of these and learn how to respond to them. The participants will also learn points to remember for approach and attitude.

**Network – Understanding God's Design For You In The Church
(Bruce Bugbee, Don Cousins, Bill Hybels)**

8 Sessions

What's Network?

This session introduces the Network Process. Participants will be "energized" as they discover the relationship between God's design for them and their individual interests, concerns, needs, and experiences.

Where Should I Serve?

In this session, the participant is exposed to the first element of the *Servant Profile*, Passion (which might relate to more familiar terms like "burden," "dream," "vision," and "call"). Passion is the God-given desire that compels us to make a difference in a particular ministry. The question "Where should I serve?" is answered by knowing our Passion.

Why Can't You Be More Like Me?

This session shows that diversity in the body of Christ is by design. We learn how the church is designed to function through the uniqueness of the individual, the diversity of individuals in the church, and our interdependence within the church. This interdependence is how God wants us to operate.

What Am I Supposed To Do?

The emphasis in this study is *practical* (as compared to other valid studies on Spiritual Gifts that might emphasize theological or other aspects of Spiritual Gifts). What are the Spiritual Gifts, how are they used in the church, and *why should we care anyway?*

What Can I do To Make A Difference?

Participants in this session further explore their possible Spiritual Gift(s), link their primary spiritual Gift with their primary Passion, and identify possible ministry areas for their Passion/Spiritual Gift combination.

What's Love Got To Do With It?

In session 6, we will explore serving with love, which is essential to serving interdependently.

How Can I Do It With Style?

In this session we examine Personal Style (how we serve), which is the last element of the Servant Profile. The participants each compile their Servant Profile and identify ministry possibilities which reflect it.

Serving Is For A Lifetime!

In this final session, we'll discuss the last principle of "how we are to serve," which is to serve for a lifetime. This session also "wraps up" the Discovery step of the Network Process. It is very important that you end on a very positive, motivational "up." Participants will leave with a clear vision for meaningful church, and will be committed to meeting with the Network consultant and beginning to serve.

Things don't always work out the way we want them to, or the way we think they will. Sometimes we don't even see it coming. We get hit with some form of pain out of nowhere leaving us feeling desperate and helpless. But that's the way life is. Still, it makes us wonder how God can let these things happen to us. How God can just stand by and watch us suffer. Where is God when it really hurts? Maybe God is actually closer to us than we think. Maybe it's when we're in these situations, where everything seems to be falling apart, that God gets an opportunity to remind us of how much He really loves us.

I love those shoes. Really? The same way I love my wife? What's up with the word "love"? It doesn't have much meaning when we use it so loosely. Maybe we don't really get it. Maybe we don't understand what real love is; what it involves to really love somebody; what it means to give yourself to someone else. We mistake things like friendship, commitment, or lust for love. But God wired us a certain way to experience all that love was really meant to be. Not to hold us back or to make us miss out on the best life has to offer. God created love, and wants us to feel it all in the way it's meant to be felt.

Trees DVD 003

We want to know why we are here; if our lives really matter; how our religion is relevant to this life today. We want to understand what significance this minute, hour, week, month, and year has to our lives; to our world. We need a God who cares about this life, in this world, right now. We want to understand why everything we think, everything we say, and everything we do matters. We don't want to just sit back and wait for something to happen or someday to come. We want to know if all the choices we make now will shape our world and lives for eternity, because we want our lives to have meaning today, and our lives today to have meaning forever.

Why do we do things we do? Why do we go to church or give money away? Because we're suppose to or because we think God needs it? Do we honestly put on our best clothes for an hour once a week, stand and sit at all the right times, and sing all the appropriate songs for God's sake, or because it'll make us look better to the world around us? We're tired of all the empty rituals and routines. And so is God. God hates it when we call ourselves Christians but ignore all the things He really cares about. He hates it when we go through hollow religious routines out of some feeling of duty or obligation. God doesn't want the meaningless rituals. God wants our hearts.

Why is silence so hard to deal with? Why is it so much easier for us to live our lives with a lot of things going on all the time than to just be in silence? We're constantly surrounded by "voices" that are influencing us on how to think, feel, and behave. Movies, music, TV, internet, cell phones, and a never-ending barrage of advertising. There's always something going on, always noise in our lives, but maybe there's a connection between the amount of noise in our lives and our inability to hear God. If God sometimes feels distant to us, maybe it's not because he's not talking to us, but simply because we aren't really listening.

We always think we know what's missing from our lives in order to really make us happy, don't we? If only I had that car, or that job, or if only I could lose those 15 lbs, then I'd be happy. Really? How often do we want something only to find out that it wasn't that great after all? Sometimes we ask God for things and if He doesn't deliver right away, we start questioning whether God really understands or even cares. Do we really trust God? Do we trust that God is good and sees a bigger picture than we ever could? It's easy to want what's right in front of us, but maybe God knows what's better for us, and sometimes we just can't see it.

Maybe a friend turned their back on you. Maybe someone you loved betrayed you. We all have wounds and we end up carrying around these things that people have done to us for weeks, months, and sometimes even years. It isn't always easy to forgive these people and after a while these hurts can get really heavy. So the only way to feel better seems to be somehow getting back the people that hurt us, to get revenge. But does revenge ever truly satisfy? Maybe forgiving isn't something you do for someone else to let them off the hook. Maybe forgiveness is about you. God didn't create you to carry these wounds around. God created you to be free.

Dust DVD 008

Believing in God is important, but what about God believing in us? Believing that we can actually be the kind of people we were meant to be. People of love, compassion, peace, forgiveness, and hope. People who try to do the right thing all of the time. It's easy for us to sometimes get down on ourselves. To feel "not good enough" or feel like we don't have what it takes. But maybe if we had more insight into the culture that Jesus grew up in and some of the radical things He did, we'd understand the faith that God has in all of us.

God loves everyone, so a Christian should, too. In fact, Jesus said that the most important thing in life is to love God with everything we've got and love others the same way. But it's not always easy to love everyone around us, is it? Sometimes we strongly disagree with other people's political views, religious beliefs, behaviors or something else, and it makes it hard to love them when we feel like we're right and they're very wrong. But Jesus doesn't separate loving God and loving others. So maybe the best way for us to show our love for God is actually by loving other people no matter how hard it sometimes is. Maybe it's the only way.

A lot of us have done things in our lives that we're ashamed of. Some are small things, and some

of us have really big and devastating things. Some of us even have things that people close to us don't know about. Personal junk that we keep to ourselves so we don't have to deal with it. Because we don't know how to deal with it, do we? We're afraid that if we try it's just going to make everything worse. But no matter how big our junk is, no matter how much what we've done has impacted the way other people feel about us or how we feel about ourselves, it hasn't changed how God feels about us. God loves us, He always has and always will, and there's nothing we can do to change that.

Living In Jesus' Name

Whatever the reason, many of us find it difficult to live an ordinary day in close connection with Jesus. If this has been true in your experience, you're in the right place. Wherever you are on your spiritual journey, Jesus really does want to be with you in your everyday life.

Everyday Relationships

If we're going to continue to live an ordinary day with Jesus, we're going to have to learn how to experience his presence in these everyday relationships. That's what this session is about.

Work

In this session we're going to explore what it means to be with Jesus in your daily work- not just how you feel about your job, or how to be more successful at it, but how to make your work an act of partnering between you and God through all aspects of your workday.

Leadings

In this session we're going to consider a very important truth- the fact that Jesus really does want to communicate with us. We're going to answer the question, *How can I listen to Jesus and follow the leadings of the Holy Spirit in the course of an ordinary day?*

Solitude

We've been talking about how to listen to God, and a key way to do that is to begin to spend time alone with him- spend solitude time with him so we can hear him.

Spiritual Pathways

In this session we're going to take a look at several spiritual temperaments or pathways and how we can use each one to connect with God.

Pace Of Life

As we've gone through each session in this course, you may have felt tension between what you're hearing in this course and the reality of your life.
